For the following, higher scores represent better outcomes: Personal Anti-Substance Use Norms, Parent Injunctive Norms, and Friend Injunctive Norms, Video Ratings.

For the following, lower scores represent better outcomes: Recent Substance Use, Substance Use Intentions, Descriptive Norms, Refusal Self-efficacy, and Positive Substance Use Expectancies.

For Substance Use Resistance Skills, higher scores generally represent better outcomes, after removing responses indicating “I was not offered” in 15-17.

For decision making skills higher scores on the first, third, and fourth items represent better outcomes, while lower scores on the second and fifth items represent better outcomes.
